#WeMakeGoodStuff Scavenger Hunt

Lesson Plan

Length: One – Two Hours

Objective: Students will:

- Identify and describe products manufactured in Central Louisiana.
- Identify major companies that Make Good Stuff in Central Louisiana.
- Identify different careers in manufacturing.

Materials:

- We Make Good Stuff Video Series https://bit.ly/WeMakeGoodStuff_youtube
- Louisiana Central: We Make Good Stuff Scavenger Hunt student worksheet.

Description of Activity:

- 1. This can be done individually or in teams of 2.
- 2. Ask the class to "Name something you think is made in Central Louisiana?" <u>Examples to share</u>: Tide Pods, Utility Poles, tanker cars for trains.
- 3. Give each student/team the We Make Good Stuff Scavenger Hunt worksheet.
- 1. Allow 20-30 minutes for students to watch the various short videos in the We Make Good Stuff video series.
- 2. Have each student/team come up and write the "3 things they learned" about products created in Central Louisiana or jobs they thought were cool.
- 1. As a class, discuss the items listed. Expand on the importance of science, technology, engineering, and math classes in middle and high school.
- Have the class brainstorm about ways which manufactured products are used in everyday activities. Think about cell phones, cars and other forms of transportation, medical devices, food, paper, metal and plastics.
