

Workforce Map



Light Job Posting Demand Over a Thin Supply of Regional Jobs




Embedded Talent

Job posting activity is low in your area. The national average for an area this size is 238* job postings/mo, while there are 54 here.










Retirement Risk Is Low, While Overall Diversity Is Low




Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is high in your area. The national average for an area this size is 3,239* racially diverse employees, while there are 3,612 here.




Gender Diversity

Unemployment shown at the 2-digit sector level.















Industry Gender Breakdown


